

NOTICE TO PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE

The Personal Representative may have **two roles** to assume when making a claim; he or she is always representing **1) the Estate** but may also be representing **2) himself/herself** if he or she is an Approved Family Member and/or Dependant of the deceased HCV Infected Person.

Joint Release

- Personal Representative May Have to Sign Twice

Where the election is either **\$72,000.00** (Form HEMO 22) or **\$120,000.00** (Form GEN 21), the Personal Representative will have to sign the Joint Release twice if he/she is **also** an Approved Family Member and/or Dependant. In such case, the Personal Representative must sign the Joint Release once as an Approved Family Member and/or Dependant and a second time as the Personal Representative acting on behalf of the Estate.

Allocation Chart

- Personal Representative May Have to Sign Twice

Where the election is either **\$72,000.00** (Form HEMO 22) or **\$120,000.00** (Form GEN 21), the Personal Representative will have to sign the Chart twice if he/she is **also** an Approved Family Member and/or Dependant. In such case, the Personal Representative must sign the Allocation Chart twice, once as an Approved Family Member and/or Dependant and a second time as the Personal Representative acting on behalf of the Estate.

- The Personal Representative Must List the Estate and All Living Family Members and/or Dependents in the Chart
(Even if the Estate or a Family Member agrees to not receive money)

Family Member Includes:

A Spouse, Child, Brother, Sister, Grandparent and Grandchild of the deceased HCV Infected Person.
A former Spouse is not included.

Dependant Includes:

A Spouse, Child, Brother, Sister, Grandparent and Grandchild if the HCV Infected Person was providing support or was under a legal obligation to provide support to such individual on the date death of the HCV Infected Person.

A former Spouse is a Dependant if the deceased HCV Infected Person was under a legal obligation to provide support to the ex-Spouse on the date of his/her death.
